Passes for Seniors/Elderly

Coralville Transit:

Free transit, anytime for Coralville and North Liberty residents only, age 65 and older on Coralville buses. For a pass, present a photo ID, verification of age (if not already on photo ID) and proof of residency at Coralville City Hall (if Coralville resident) or North Liberty City Hall (if North Liberty resident).

Iowa City Transit:

- Age 60 or older (low-income): Free transit, during off-peak hours for Iowa City and University Heights residents only. M-F 9:00am—3:30pm, and after 6:30pm, and all day Saturday. Special pass required, must apply and meet qualifications. Verify age and return completed “Free Elderly Low Income Off Peak Pass” form to DHS at 855 S Dubuque St Iowa City, IA or Social Security 1100 6th St Coralville, IA.
- Age 60 or older (not low-income): \$0.50 transit fare, during off-peak hours for Iowa City and University Heights residents only. M-F 9:00am—3:30pm, and after 6:30pm, and all day Saturday. Complete the “\$0.50 Senior Off-Peak Pass for Persons 60 years or older” form and submit it in person at Transportation Services 335 E Iowa Ave Iowa City, IA. Must provide proof of age at this time.

Passes for People with Disabilities

Coralville Transit: Free transit, anytime for Coralville and North Liberty residents only on Coralville buses. Complete the top portion of the “Disabled Bus Pass Program” form. Have a physician complete and sign the bottom section. Return the complete form to Coralville City Hall (if Coralville resident) or North Liberty City Hall (if North Liberty resident) with a current photo ID and proof of residency to receive a pass.

Iowa City Transit: Free transit, during off-peak hours for Iowa City and University Heights residents only. M-F 9:00am—3:30pm, and after 6:30pm, and all day Saturday. Complete the top portion of the “Disabled Bus Pass Program” form. Have a physician complete the bottom portion. Turn the completed form into Transportation Services 335 E Iowa Ave Iowa City, IA.

Riding between both systems?

Coralville Transit: Riders with an “Iowa City Transit Low Income Elderly pass” can ride for **free** during off peak hours on Coralville Transit buses. Riders with a “Iowa City Transit 50 Cents Elderly pass” can ride for **50 cents a ride** during off peak hours on Coralville Transit buses. Riders with an “Iowa City Transit Disabled pass” can ride Coralville Transit buses for **free** during off peak hours. Coralville Transit Off-Peak Hours = M-F from 9:00am-3:00pm, and after 6:00pm, and all day Saturday.

Iowa City Transit: Riders with a “Coralville Transit Elderly pass” can ride for **50 cents a ride** during off peak hours on Iowa City Transit buses. Riders with a “Coralville Transit Disabled pass” can ride Iowa City Transit buses for **free** during off peak hours. Iowa City Transit Off-Peak Hours = M-F from 9:00am-3:30pm, and after 6:30pm, and all day Saturday.

Iowa City Transit: \$27.00 for a 31-day pass. Complete “Reduced fare 31-day pass” form. Include proof of residency (i.e. electric bill) and return the form to DHS at 855 S Dubuque St. or Social Security 1100 6th Street Coralville, IA.	Coralville Transit: Free transit, anytime. Show SEATS card upon boarding. Iowa City Transit: Free transit, during off-peak hours. M-F from 9:00am—3:30pm, and after 6:30pm, and all day Saturday. Present card upon boarding.	Coralville Transit: \$0.50 fare during off-peak hours. M-F from 9:00am—3:00pm, and after 6:00pm, and all day Saturday. Present card upon boarding. 380 Express Bus - Service between Iowa City and Cedar Rapids

Senior and Disabled Fares ½ Price

- Full cost one-way fare is \$3.50; half price one-way fare is \$1.75
 - 60 and older: Government Issued ID must be presented to driver when boarding
 - Proof of Disability – Medicaid ID or a Disability ID issued by local transit agency or human service agency.
- Passengers in wheelchairs do not need to present proof of disability. If you have a current disabled ID from a local transit agency, those will be accepted for the 380Express service.

Johnson County SEATS:

SEATS is open to the general public and also provides paratransit and rural service.

Paratransit: Provides ADA Paratransit Service for individuals with disabilities that cannot board, ride, or get to an accessible fixed route Coralville or Iowa City bus due to their disability. Rides with SEATS are scheduled in advance by calling (319)339-6125. For general ride information call (319)339-6127. All riders must apply and be certified by the cities in where they reside. Each city has their own set of requirements:
Coralville: (319)248-1790; Iowa City: (319)356-5151; North Liberty: (319)248-1790; University Heights: (319)337-6900.

Rural Service: SEATS Service is available to the general public in rural areas. No application is required, eligibility is determined when address is shared. Call (319)339-6125 to schedule. At least 24 hour and no more than two weeks in advance. The more advance notice the better. Rural trips can be denied due to capacity issues. Rural trips are scheduled as follows:

- Northeast:** Solon, Shueyville, Swisher, Morse, Oasis and surrounding areas — Mon, Tuesday, Thursday 8:30AM to 4:30PM
- South:** Lone Tree, Sharon Center, Hills, Fry Town and surrounding areas — Monday, Wednesday, Friday 8:30AM to 4:30PM
- West:** Oxford, Tiffin, Cosgrove and surrounding areas — Tuesday, Thursday 8:30AM to 4:30PM

SEATS One-way fare = **\$2.00 (for both paratransit or rural trips)**
