

COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER

Origin: *Code of Iowa* Chapter 331.801: County Medical Examiner

Number of Members: One (1) County Medical Examiner

Appointed by: The Johnson County Board of Supervisors
To serve as a county medical examiner a person shall be licensed in Iowa as a doctor of medicine and surgery, a doctor of osteopathic medicine and surgery, or an osteopathic physician. The medical examiner shall be appointed by the board from lists of two or more names submitted by the medical society and the osteopathic society of the county in which the candidate resides. If names are not submitted by either society, the board may appoint any licensed physician, osteopathic physician and surgeon, or osteopathic physician of the county.

Term: The County Medical Examiner serves a two (2) year term, beginning on the first day of January that is not a Sunday or holiday.

DEPUTY COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER(S)

- Origin: *Iowa Administrative Code* Section 641 Chapter 127.8: Deputy County Medical Examiners
- Number of Members: One, or more, Deputy County Medical Examiner, upon approval by the Johnson County Board of Supervisors and the State Medical Examiner
- Appointed by: The County Medical Examiner
A Deputy County Medical Examiner shall be licensed in the state of Iowa as a medical or osteopathic physician or surgeon.
- Duties: A Deputy County Medical Examiner shall serve at the direction of the County Medical Examiner and may perform any duty of a County Medical Examiner which is delegated by the County Medical Examiner to the Deputy County Medical Examiner.
- Term: A Deputy Medical Examiner serves a two (2) year term, beginning on the first day of January that is not a Sunday or holiday.
