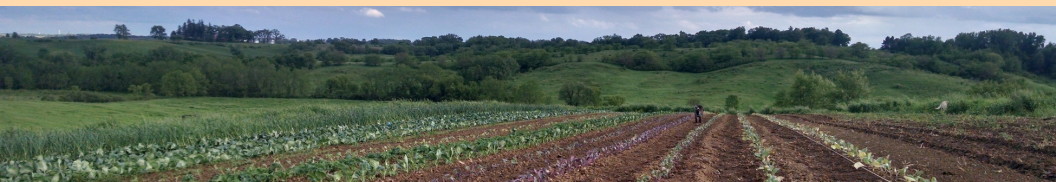


SNAP RESOURCES FOR DIRECT MARKET FARMERS



Do people use SNAP for local veggies?



YES! In 2020, 1.75 million SNAP dollars were used on local produce.¹

Do I have to be a farmers market?



No! You can accept SNAP benefits as a direct market farmer. Just fill out the store application.

Do CSA models work with SNAP?



They can! You can accept SNAP as monthly installment plans or ask customers' preferences.



Apply to Accept SNAP



1. Download Johnson County's SNAP Guide for Farmers
2. Create a USDA account
3. Complete the store application
4. Upload required documentation
5. Wait for authorization
