

# Johnson County Community ID

The Community ID is a local government-issued photo identification available to residents of Johnson County. The ID was established to ensure that all members of our diverse community are welcomed and can participate fully in the economic and social life of our county.



## Ways to use the ID

- Open a bank account at participating banks
- Confirm your identity when using credit cards
- Interact with schools, city & county agencies, or law enforcement officials
- Enjoy discounts at participating businesses

*This ID cannot be used to get a driver's license, board a plane, purchase age-restricted products, prove employment eligibility, or vote.*

## How to get the ID

Visit the Johnson County Auditor's Office at 913 S. Dubuque St. between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm Monday through Friday. There you will:

- Fill out an application
- Show proof of identity **and** residency (see reverse)
- Pay a fee (\$8 for adults, \$4 for children)
- Have your picture taken
- Confirm the accuracy of your card

*Community ID cards must be mailed to the applicant's address.*



# Most Common Accepted Documents

This list does not include **all** of the accepted documents for the Community ID. Please visit [johnsoncountyiowa.gov/communityid](http://johnsoncountyiowa.gov/communityid) for the complete list and further details.

## Proof of Identity

**One** of the following:

- U.S. or foreign passport
- U.S. driver's license or non-driver's ID
- U.S. permanent resident card (Green Card)
- Consular ID
- Birth certificate (persons 16 years or younger only)

Or **two** of the following:

- National ID card
- Foreign driver's license
- Visa
- Identification card issued by an Iowa education institution
- Certified copy of U.S. or foreign birth certificate
- Official school or medical record with birth date (persons 13 years or younger only)

## Cost

The Community ID costs \$8 for adults and is valid for four years; for minors, it costs \$4 and is valid for two years. If a cardholder moves to another Johnson County address, a replacement card with the accurate address will cost \$2, within 30 days of the move.

## Proof of Residency

*Must contain the applicant's name and Johnson County address*

- Utility bill\*
- Insurance bill (homeowner's renter's, health, life, or automobile)\*
- Medical bill\*
- Bank statement\*
- Employment pay stub\*
- Proof of minor enrolled in public or private school in Johnson County
- Voter registration card
- Original documents from health or social services organization attesting to at least fifteen days Johnson County residency\*
- Jury summons or court order issued by a state or federal court\*
- Current rental agreement
- Current mobile home lot payment receipt
- Current Johnson County vehicle registration

*\*Must be dated within the last 30 days*
