

## Alternative Boundary (document date 10/24/2022)

Supported by input received to date, there are two potential boundaries being distributed with the Public Hearing Draft.

**The final boundary has not been determined.** The Planning and Zoning Commission (PZC) will recommend a boundary to the Board of Supervisors, who will then set the final boundary as part of their review and approval process during the public meeting(s) where the plan will be presented and considered. The PZC and the Board of Supervisors will consider community feedback and input leading up to and during their respective public hearing processes on the proposed plan

The boundary shown on page 9 of the Public Hearing Draft is the boundary being recommended by PDS staff. The alternative boundary shown below was suggested by some members of the community in early October after the two community meetings and is being included in this mailing to attendees, residents and property owners. This alternative boundary, along with the Public Hearing Draft, will also be posted to the County website, and included in the agenda packets for the PCZ and Board of Supervisors' meetings.
