STEPS TO APPLY FOR AN ALCOHOL LICENSE IN JOHNSON COUNTY, IOWA

Once the online application is submitted, the Auditor's Office will contact the applicant to begin the local authority process.

REQUIRED

Step 1. Complete the online application with the <u>lowa</u>
Alcoholic Beverages Division
(ABD) at at least 45 days before the event/effective date.

REQUIRED

Step 2. Submit the local authority paperwork to the Auditor's Office
30 days before the event/effective date.

Auditor's Office processes the local authority review of application.

Board of Supervisors votes on the application. If approved, the Auditor's Office will endorse the application with Iowa ABD.

Iowa ABD completes its review process and emails license to applicant unless otherwise denied by ABD.

Once the Auditor's Office completes the internal review process, staff will schedule the application for a vote at a regularly scheduled Board of Supervisors' meeting.

Once the Auditor's Office ensorses the application with the Iowa ABD, the ABD completes its final review and emails license to applicant.

The Auditor's Office will contact the applicant if the paperwork is incomplete or the application has incorrect information.

If the Board votes to deny the application, contact lowa ABD to determine your next steps.
