How Can We Help?

We can help if you have refugee status.

Appointments are available to complete the I-693 form for your one-year health assessment.

Appointments are also available for you and your family to get the vaccines that you need for work, school, and immigration.

How Long Does It Take?

After your first appointment, the whole process for the vaccine review will take about 4 weeks.

What Does It Cost?

There is no charge for us to fill out the form for you.

Additional costs will depend on what vaccines are needed, and your insurance status. These costs will be paid at any clinic visits you have.

For each family member you will need:

- ◆ Alien number (A-number, or USCIS #)
- ◆ Employment Card/ Authorization Permit or another photo ID
- ◆ Previous medical records (if any)
- ◆ Insurance cards (if any)
