VINE is a free service that allows you to anonymously check an offender's custody status by phone, website, or mobile app (where available). You can also register to receive automated notifications about changes in custody status by phone, email, text, or in-app. TTY service for people with hearing loss is also available.

How to Use VINE

- If you feel you are in danger, call 911 immediately.
- VINE is confidential. The offender will not know you are registered with this service.
- VINE provides information on offenders in custody in lowa.
- VINE notifies automatically when an offender's custody status changes. You may get a notification from VINE in the middle of the night.
- Write down your PIN and keep it in a safe place. For safety reasons, do not share this information with others.
- If you do not answer a notification call, a message will be left and additional attempts will continue to be made for a minimum of 24 hours, or until you enter your PIN.
- You can register multiple phone numbers and email addresses for notifications.
- If you forget your PIN, call the toll-free number and press zero. You will be transferred to an operator who can help you reset your PIN or cancel the notification.
- · Operators are available 24/7 to assist you.




Notification Events

- Release

- Death (in most cases)
