## Inspection Published Comment:

This is the second pre-opening inspection for this establishment; the first inspection was conducted on 5/8/2025.

#### License Status: Not Approved

The food service license is not approved at this time. During this inspection, it was observed that the facility is selling TCS (Time/Temperature Control for Safety) foods, including dairy-based ice cream and a hot-hold cheese sauce, without an approved license. The facility still does not have the required handwashing sink or three-compartment warewashing sink as outlined in their original license application.

TCS foods may only be prepared, stored, or sold in an approved facility. Selling these foods without a license poses a significant public health risk and is prohibited under the lowa Food Code. Establishments found in violation may be subject to enforcement actions until full compliance is achieved. Additionally, a double fee may be applied when the establishment seeks a license after completing all required corrections.

It is the responsibility of the person in charge to contact the inspector to schedule a follow-up pre-opening inspection once all required equipment and corrective actions are in place.
