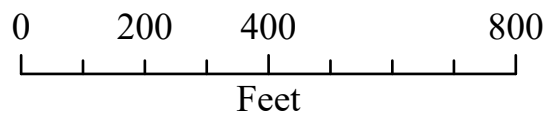
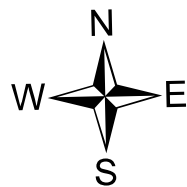

The Special Events application for the State Park Firework Displays - Lake MacBride July 4th Fireworks Show at Lake Macbride State Park on 7/3/2026 has been approved.

This permit is granted by the authority of the Department of Natural Resources as provided in Iowa Code section 461A.42. This permit is not transferable to another entity and it does not relieve the permittee/sponsor from obtaining other permits required by the state or its political subdivisions.

This issuance of this permit is subject to the following stipulations and conditions.

Authorized event activities include: Fireworks Display

Authorized vendors for this event include: N/A

The event is open to the public.

Stipulations:

- * Permittee/sponsor is responsible for all activities at this event, such as, but not limited to, signage (as approved by DNR) for event participants and spectators, crowd control, traffic control, and parking lot control.
- * Care will be exercised to prevent damage to state park, recreation area, or forest campground property. Any state park, recreation area or forest campground property damaged or destroyed by the permittee/sponsor shall be promptly repaired or replaced by the permittee/sponsor to the satisfaction of the DNR.
- * No vehicles (staff, participants or spectators) are allowed off roadways without prior approval from park staff. Parking on roadways shall not restrict or block access by emergency vehicles.
- * Parking on roadways shall not restrict or block access by emergency vehicles.
- * Temporary signs placed on or around state park, recreation area, or forest campground property shall not hinder or block traffic and shall be removed once the event is over. Prior approval from park staff is required for any advertising or banners. After the event, the permittee/sponsor is responsible for cleaning up the area and removing all trash, signs, port-a-potties, and any other equipment or materials brought to the event within 24 hours. Litter generated during the event shall be picked up and properly disposed of by the permittee/sponsor. Clean-up shall take place during normal state park hours of 4:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.
- * Permittee/sponsor shall clean up after the event and remove all trash, signs, port-a-potties, and any other equipment or materials brought to the event within 24 hours of the conclusion of the event. Clean up shall take place during normal state park hours of 4:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.
- * Permittee/sponsor shall have a copy of the approved special event permit on hand during the event and shall provide proof of insurance at least two weeks prior to the event taking place. The certificate of liability insurance shall list the DNR as an additional insured party.
- * All state park/recreation area rules and regulations shall be followed unless special stipulations have been made.
- * Permittee/sponsor understands and agrees that neither the State of Iowa, nor the Department of Natural Resources shall be responsible for any injury to persons or damage to property arising out of or incidental to the activities which are the subject of this permit. The permittee/sponsor agrees by execution hereof to indemnify and hold harmless the State of Iowa and the Department of Natural Resources against all liabilities, costs, and expenses which may arise in consequence of the permittee's/sponsor's activities related to this permit.

* Permittee/sponsor shall provide proof of insurance at least two weeks prior to the event taking place. The certificate of liability insurance shall list the DNR as an additional insured party.

* Permittee/sponsor shall be responsible for obtaining all necessary authorizations and adhering to all regulations required by various federal, state, and local agencies regarding the event activities.

* See additional "Special Conditions and Considerations" listed below.

* The permittee/sponsor shall take adequate safety precautions to ensure that persons not actively involved in conducting the display remain a safe distance from the firing area and any areas containing set pieces.

* The DNR representative in charge of the area in which the display is being conducted or any state peace officer may halt any display when the character, location, weather or firing of the display makes it hazardous to property or dangerous to any person or persons.

* Any fireworks that remain unfired after the display is concluded shall be immediately disposed of by the operator or the sponsoring entity in a way safe for the particular type of fireworks remaining.

* The permittee/sponsor shall make arrangements for firefighting equipment and emergency medical services to be on the scene at all times during the firing of the display.

* The permittee/sponsor shall be totally responsible for the cleanup of the fireworks display site at the conclusion of the display.

The DNR shall be listed as an additional insured or beneficiary of the policy for this special event (minimum \$1,000,000). The policy shall, at minimum, provide coverage during the entire length of the event. Failure to provide this proof of insurance may result in the event being canceled by the DNR.

Please contact park staff for a discussion regarding the emergency response plan and parking.

DNR shall not be responsible for event safety or event security. It is the responsibility of the event organizer.

Park will remain open to other park visitors.

The event organizer must have people onsite that are CPR and First-aid certified.
