## **F67 (540<sup>th</sup> St SW) Project Work to Begin Early to Mid-May Project #FM-C052(130)--55-52**

**Johnson County, Iowa** – Weather permitting, the Contractor and Secondary Roads expect work on the F67 improvements from Hwy 1 to Iowa County to begin as early as the week ending May 08, 2026. The road will generally be open to traffic during construction, but travelers should expect brief delays due to daytime lane closures. Traffic will be reduced to one lane during working hours using flaggers and pilot cars. Both lanes will be fully open to traffic at night except for unusual circumstances. Road closures will be announced in advance using Portable Dynamic Message Signs (PDMS.)

INROADS, LLC. of Des Moines, Iowa, is the Prime Contractor. The project should be substantially complete before school starts in Mid-August with favorable weather. Workers and equipment will be present in the work zone throughout construction, so PLEASE be alert, slow down, and drive defensively in the project corridor. We need your help to ensure everyone goes home, every night. Your patience and understanding are greatly appreciated while we complete this much needed \$4.6 million dollar investment in our infrastructure.
